Invitation to Submit a Proposal for Operating Container Terminal II of the Dar es Salaam Port

Tanzania Ports Authority (TPA) was established in year 2004 under the Act of Parliament CAP. 166. The legal mandate of the TPA as provided in the Act is to develop, manage and operate ports in Tanzania. Major coastal ports are Dar es Salaam which is the principal port handling over ninety (90) percent of cargo for Tanzania and land linked countries using Tanzanian ports.

At the Dar es Salaam Port, there are two (2) Container Terminals operated by TPA, namely; Container Terminal I (Berths Numbers 5 to 7) and Container Terminal II (Berths Number 8 to 11). The Container Terminal II has a quay length of 725 metres and capacity to handle over 660,000 TEU per annum depending on, amongst other, type of equipment deployed, ICT systems and yard configuration.

Pursuant to Section 5(e) of the Ports Act CAP 166, the Tanzania Ports Authority (TPA) invites reputable terminal operators in Tanzania and abroad to submit a proposal for operating the Container Terminal II (Berths Numbers 8 to 11) of the Dar es Salaam Port.

At a minimum, the proposal should include: Container Throughput, Net Moves per Crane per hour, Yard Utilization, Ship Turn Round Time and Import and Export Container Dwell Time. Any additional information shall be an added advantage to the extent deemed appropriate by TPA.

The proposal should be addressed to the Director General and submitted within two (2) weeks from the date of this announcement through the address provided below.
